EFFECT OF THE ORDER.

(a) Intoxicating Liquor (other than Spirits).

3. (a) During such time as this Order is in force it shall be lawful, notwithstanding anything contained in Article 2 of the respective Orders of the Board for the aforesaid areas, to sell and supply in licensed premises and clubs intoxicating liquor (other than spirits) for consumption off the premises, and to dispatch and take therefrom such intoxicating liquor during all hours in the afternoon after the conclusion of the midday hours and before the commencement of the evening hours by the said Article in each of the said Orders respectively prescribed, and the said Article in each of the said Orders shall be read as if such additional hours were expressly inserted therein.

(b) Spirits.

(b) During such time as this Order is in force there shall be substituted in Article 3 (a) of each of the said Orders the hour of 5.30 p.m. for the hour prescribed by the said paragraph of the said Article, and the said Article in each of the said Orders shall be read as if the hour of 5.30 p.m. were expressly inserted in the said paragraph.

OTHER PROVISIONS OF THE ORDERS TO REMAIN IN FORCE.

4. Save as by this Order expressly provided, the provisions of each of the said Orders shall remain in full force.
