

ORDER OF THE BOARD OF
AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

(DATED 14TH DECEMBER 1915.)

The Board of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in them under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1914, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

(1) Notwithstanding the provisions of Part II of the Glastonbury District (Foot-and-Mouth Disease) Order of 1915, cattle, sheep, goats and swine moved by railway from premises not situate in any area which is for the time being a Zone or Prohibited Area for the purposes of any Order of the Board relating to Foot-and-Mouth Disease to Langport railway station, on the Durston and Yeovil branch of the Great Western Railway, may be moved from such station to the sale mentioned in the Schedule hereto, and animals exposed at such sale may be moved to the said station for transit to any premises not situate in a Prohibited Area.

(2) Animals moved to or from such sale along that part of the road leading from Curry Rivel to Langport as is situate in the parish of Huish Episcopi shall not be deemed to be moved into or out of the Zone described in the Schedule to the above Order if the animals are moved through such parish by such road.

GLASTONBURY DISTRICT (FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE) ORDER OF 1915 (No. 2).

The Board of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in them under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1914, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

Substitution of New Prohibited Area and Zone.

1. The Glastonbury District (Foot-and-Mouth Disease) Order of 1915 shall be read and have effect as if the Prohibited Area and Zone described in the Schedule hereto were substituted for the Prohibited Area and Zone described in the Schedule to that Order.

Commencement.

2. This Order shall come into operation on the eighteenth day of December, nineteen hundred and fifteen.
