Special Acts (Extension of Time) Act, 1915:
Extending Time for operation of certain provisions of the Chesterfield Gas and Water Board Act, 1911.

CHESTERFIELD GAS AND WATER BOARD.

To the Chesterfield Gas and Water Board,—

And to all others whom it may concern

WHEREAS by sections 11 and 12 of the Chesterfield Gas and Water Board Act, 1911 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act

of 1911"), the times within which the powers for the compulsory purchase of lands and for making and completing the works by that Act authorised might be exercised are limited,

And whereas by subsection (1) of section 26 of the Act of 1911 the said Board are required in the event in that sub-section mentioned to give notice to treat for the purchase of the lands required for Work No. 10 within the period by that section limited.

Now therefore, We, the Local Government Board, in pursuance of the powers given to Us by section 1 of the Special Acts (Extension of Time) Act, 1915, and of any other powers in that behalf, by this Our Order extend for a period of one year the time limited by section 12 of the Act of 1911 for the completion of the works specified in paragraph (A) of sub-section (2) of that section and by section 11 and sub-section (1) of section 26 of the Act of 1911 in relation to the acquisition of the lands required for the said Work No. 10.
