#### ISSUE OF WAR EXPENDITURE CERTIFICATES.

Under Act 5 & 6, Geo. V. c. 55.

Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that, as from the 3rd June, until further notice, War Expenditure Certificates will be issued under the above-mentioned Act, at a fixed rate of discount, which will be subject to variation from time to time without previous notice.

2. The Certificates will be in amounts of £1,000, £5,000 or £10,000, and will be drawn

for two years from date of issue.

3. Particulars of the rate of discount for the time being in force will be notified to applicants at the Bank of England.

4. Applications must be made on printed forms, and must be lodged at the Chief Cashier's Office, Bank of England, before 12.30

o'clock (Saturdays 12 o'clock).
5. The persons whose applications are accepted will be informed of the same, and payment in full of the amount due must be made to the Bank of England not later than Three o'clock the same day (Saturday One o'clock) by means of cash or Banker's Draft on the Bank of England.

6. The Lords Commissioners Majesty's Treasury reserve the right of reject-

ing any application.

7. Forms of application may be obtained at the Chief Cashier's Office, Bank of England.
