**BOROUGH OF BARROW-IN-FURNESS.**

Notice is hereby given, that the Local Government Board, by an Order dated the 27th day of July, 1916, have made a Regulation under section 8 of the Motor Car Act, 1903, which will come into operation on the 7th day of August, 1916, limiting the speed at which a heavy motor car may be driven on the opening span portion of Walney Bridge, Barrow-in-Furness, to 5 miles per hour, and on the remaining portion of the Bridge to 10 miles per hour.
