the Army Council, sells, removes or secretes any such Hides, or deals with them in any way contrary to any condition imposed in any licence, permit or order that may be granted or made in respect thereof, he will be guilty of an offence against the Defence of the Realm (Consolidation) Regulations, 1914.

All Hides now in process of conversion into Leather are excepted from the provision of this

Order.
