ORDER AS TO SUPREME COURT FEES, 1916.

- I, the Right Honourable Stanley Owen Baron Buckmaster, Lord High Chancellor of Great Britain, by and with the advice of the undersigned Judges of the Supreme Court and with the concurrence of the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury, do hereby in pursuance and execution of the powers given by the Supreme Court of Judicature Act, 1875, and all other powers enabling me in that behalf order and direct in manner following:—
- 1. Where any summons is sealed or issued solely for the purpose of an application in the Chancery Division for leave to deposit with the Treasury any securities in Court under any Treasury securities deposit scheme no fee shall be taken upon the summons nor upon any order made thereon.
- 2. This Order shall come into operation forthwith and may be cited as the Order as to Supreme Court Fees (Deposit of Securities with the Treasury), 1916.
