

FIRST SCHEDULE.

An Area in the administrative county of the West Riding of Yorkshire, comprising such parts of the parishes of Weston, Denton, Nesfield with Langbar, Beamsley, Blubberhouses, Hazlewood with Storiths, Timble Great, Askwith, Newall with Clifton, Otley, and Middleton, as lie within the following boundary (*but excluding the roads and river forming parts of such boundary*), namely:—

A boundary commencing at Bolton Bridge over the River Wharfe on the main road from

Skipton to Harrogate, and proceeding in an easterly direction along that road to the cross-roads near St. Andrew's Church, Blubberhouses; thence in a south-easterly direction along Cooper Lane, Rues Lane, Sourby Lane, Askwith Moor Road, and Weston Moor Road to its junction with Newall Carr Road; thence in a southerly direction along Newall Carr Road, and Billiams Hill to Otley Bridge over the River Wharfe at Otley; thence in westerly and north-westerly directions along the northern bank of that river to the point of commencement.

RHONDDA & SWANSEA BAY RAILWAY ACT, 1914.

BY virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by the Special Acts (Extension of Time) Act, 1915, the Board of

Trade hereby Order that the time limited for the compulsory purchase of certain lands required for the construction of the works described in Section 5 of the Rhondda and Swansea Bay Railway Act, 1914, and the lands authorised to be acquired by section 14 of the said Act shall be extended for one year from the 8th day of July, 1917.

SPECIAL ACTS (EXTENSION OF TIME) ACT, 1915.

MANCHESTER CORPORATION ACT, 1911.

BY virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred on them by the Special Acts (Extension of Time) Act 1915, the Board of Trade hereby Order that the time limited by Section 31 of the Manchester Corporation Act 1911 for the completion of the tramways, and for the compulsory purchase of lands for and in respect of the street widenings and works referred to in the said Section except a portion of Tramway two hundred and ten yards in length or thereabouts being so much of Tramway No. 2 authorised by the Manchester Southern Tramways Act 1903 as was authorised to be constructed in the Urban District of Cheadle and Gatley, shall be extended by a further year from the 18th day of August, 1917.
