#### BOYS' HOME INDUSTRIAL SCHOOL, REGENT'S PARK ROAD, PRIMROSE HILL, N.W.

The Secretary of State for the Home Department hereby gives notice that, being satisfied that there is accommodation at the Boys' Home Industrial School, Regent's Park Road, Primrose Hill, N.W., for one hundred and forty-six boys, he has sanctioned an increase of six in the number of inmates of the said School during the continuance of the present war and for three months thereafter.

The number of inmates at any one time in the said School, whether sent thereto in pursuance of the provisions of the Children Act, 1908, or of the Elementary Education Act, 1876, or otherwise, shall not exceed one hundred and forty-six.
