

tangled in fractured pipes and other wreckage, was hauled up alive.

At the same time Stoker Petty Officer Powell was found floating in the water on the port side of the engine room. The rope was lowered again and passed around Powell, who, however, was found to be dead on reaching the deck.

The water was so high that further efforts to discover the remaining Artificer left in the engine room would have been useless, and the attempt had to be abandoned.
