Special Acts (Extension of Time) Act, 1915: Extending Time for Operation of Section 50 of the Corporation of London (Bridges) Act, 1911.

To the Mayor, Aldermen, and Commons of the City of London in Common Council assembled;—

And to all others whom it may concern.

WHEREAS by virtue of Section 50 of the Corporation of London (Bridges)
Act, 1911 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1911"), and of an Order dated the 6th day of May, 1916, issued by Us, the Local Government Board, under Section 1 of the Special Acts (Extension of Time) Act, 1915 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1915"), the time limited for the exercise of the powers of the Mayor and Commonalty and Citizens of the City of London, Trustees of the Bridge House Estates (in the Act of 1911, and hereinafter referred to as "the Corporation"), for the compulsory purchase of lands for the purposes of the Act of 1911 will expire on the 18th day of August, 1917:

Now, therefore, in pursuance of the powers given to Us by Section 1 of the Act of 1915, and of any other powers in that behalf, We, by this Our Order, extend until the 18th day of August, 1918, the time limited as aforesaid for

Special Acts (Extension of Time) Act, 1915: Extending Time limited by Section 11 of the Manchester Corporation Act, 1914.

CITY OF MANCHESTER.

To the Lord Mayor, Aldermen, and Citizens of the City of Manchester;— And to all others whom it may concern.

WHEREAS by Section 11 of the Manchester Corporation Act, 1914 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1914"), it is provided that the powers of the Lord Mayor, Aldermen, and Citizens of the City of Manchester (hereinafter referred to as "the Corporation") for the compulsory purchase of lands for the purposes of Part VI of the Act of 1914 shall cease after the expiration of three years from the 7th day of August, 1914:

Now, therefore, We, the Local Government Board, in pursuance of the powers given to Us by Section 1 of the Special Acts (Extension of Time) Act, 1915, and of any other powers in that behalf, by this Our Order extend for a period of one year the time limited by Section 11 of the Act of 1914 for the exercise of the powers of the Corporation for the compulsory purchase of the said lands.
