

bishop of Canterbury, hath, pursuant to the provisions of the said Acts, duly prepared, and laid before His Majesty in Council, a Certificate in writing, bearing date the 29th day of March, 1917, in the words following:—

“ We, Randall Thomas, Archbishop of the Province of Canterbury, Primate of all England and Metropolitan, do hereby certify to Your Majesty in Council:—

“ That the Right Reverend Charles, Lord Bishop of Oxford, as Bishop of the Diocese within which are situate the Vicarage of Bampton Proper, and the Vicarage of Bampton Lew, both in the County of Oxford, having represented unto us that the said Benefices, being contiguous to each other and of which the aggregate population does not exceed 1,500 persons, might with advantage to the interests of religion be united into one Benefice, we inquired into the circumstances of the case:

“ That on such Inquiry it appeared to us that such Union might be usefully made, and would not be of inconvenient extent, and that the Dean and Chapter of the Cathedral Church of St. Peter in Exeter, being the Patrons or persons entitled to present to both the said Benefices of Bampton Proper and Bampton Lew, have consented to the proposed Union:

“ That 6 weeks and upwards before certifying such Inquiry and Consent to Your Majesty in Council we caused a Copy in writing of the aforesaid Representation of the said Lord Bishop to be affixed to the Principal Outer Door of the Parish Church of each of the said Benefices, with notice to any person or persons interested that he, she, or they might, within such 6 weeks, show cause in writing under his, her, or their hand or hands, to us, the said Archbishop, against such Union, and no such cause has been shown:

“ The Representation of the said Lord Bishop of Oxford, our Inquiry into the circumstances of the case, the Statement of Circumstances in reply thereto, the Consent in writing of the said Patrons, and the Copies of the Representation and Notices before mentioned, are hereunto annexed:

“ And we do hereby certify the Inquiry and Consent aforesaid to Your Majesty in Council, to the intent that Your Majesty in Council may, in case Your Majesty in Council shall think fit so to do, make and issue an Order for uniting the said Benefices into one Benefice, with Cure of Souls, for ecclesiastical purposes only.

“ RANDALL, CANTUAR.”

Now, therefore, His Majesty in Council, by and with the advice of His said Council, is pleased to order, as it is hereby ordered, that the Vicarage of Bampton Proper, situate in the County and Diocese of Oxford, and the Vicarage of Bampton Lew, situate in the same County and Diocese, shall be united into one Benefice, with Cure of Souls, for ecclesiastical purposes only.

WHEREAS His Majesty has been pleased, in exercise of the power in that behalf conferred on Him by Section one,

sub-section one, of the Trading with the Enemy (Extension of Powers) Act, 1915, by divers Proclamations, and in particular by a Proclamation dated the 23rd day of May, 1916, entitled “ The Trading with the Enemy (Statutory List) Proclamation, 1916, No. 3,” to prohibit all persons or bodies of persons, incorporated or unincorporated, resident, carrying on business, or being in the United Kingdom from trading with any of the persons or bodies of persons mentioned in the List contained in the last mentioned Proclamation, such List being therein referred to as “ the Statutory List ”:

And whereas by Section one, sub-section two, of the said Act, it is provided that any List of persons and bodies of persons, incorporated or unincorporated, with whom such trading is prohibited by a Proclamation under the said Act may be varied or added to by an Order made by the Lords of the Council on the recommendation of a Secretary of State:

And whereas the Statutory List contained in the last mentioned Proclamation has been varied and added to by subsequent Orders of Council:

And whereas there was this day read at the Board a recommendation from the Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs to the following effect:—

That the “ Statutory List ” should be further varied and added to as set forth in the Schedule hereto.

Now, therefore, Their Lordships, having taken the said recommendation into consideration, are pleased to order, and it is hereby ordered, that the Statutory List be varied and added to as set forth in the Schedule hereto.

Whereof the Right Honourable Arthur James Balfour, one of His Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State, the Controller of the Foreign Trade Department, and all other persons whom it may concern, are to take notice and govern themselves accordingly.
