RAFFIA (PRICES) ORDER, 1917.

In pursuance of the powers conferred on them by the Defence of the Realm Regulations, the Army Council do hereby order as follows:—

1. No person shall, without a permit issued by or on behalf of the Director of Army Contracts, sell any Raffia arrived or to arrive in the United Kingdom at prices other than those set out in the Schedule hereto annexed; provided that nothing herein contained shall apply to any stock of Raffia of less than 2 cwt. or to any Raffia in respect of which any licence

may be or may have been granted by or on behalf of the Director of Army Contracts.

2. This Order may be cited as the Raffia (Prices) Order, 1917.
