#### MESOPOTAMIA DESPATCHES.

In the Despatch from General Sir John Nixon, K.C.B., dated 17th January, 1916 (published in The London Gazette, No. 29576, dated 10th May, 1916), the following amendment is notified:—

Paragraph 18 (page 4659), lines 1 to 6 should be cancelled, and the following passage substituted:—

"The ships reached Umm Al Tubal in the afternoon of 30th November and remained in company with the troops for the night. General Townshend issued orders for a resumption of the withdrawal in the morning; but during the night the enemy came up and attacked in great strength at daylight on 1st December."
