The Trade Board will consider any objections to the above proposal to vary which may be lodged with them within three months from the 1st July, 1918. Such objections should be in writing and signed by the person making the same (adding his or her full name and address) and should be sent to the Secretary of the Shirt-making Trade Board (Great Britain), 5, Chancery Lane, London, W.C. 2.

It is desirable that the objections should state precisely, and so far as possible with reasons, what is objected to.
