Edinburgh, May 25. The Parliament met yesterday, and had under Consideration the Report from the Committee for Fitting out and Maintaining Five Frigats to secure our Trade and Coasts, and after some time spent therein adjourned the farther Debate thereof till their next meeting; and then the Parliament was adjourned till Monday next. The Commissioners appointed to Enquire into the Business of *Glenkoe*, have Examined several Persons, and sent for Colonel *Hill*, and some other Officers from *Fort-William* in the *Highlands*, to be likewise Examined concerning this Matter. This day was published at the Marker-Cross, the Act about Regulating the Proceedings of the Session.

Falmouth, May 27. Yesterday came into this Port the *St. Francisco* of and from *St. Sebastian*, laden with Wine and Brandy. And this morning arrived here the *Spanish-Expediton* in 7 days from *Corunna*.

Plymouth, May 30. This morning passed by this place the homeward bound *Lisbon* and *Porto* Fleet, being in all 70 odd Sail, under Convoy of several Men of War; as also the *Tyger* with about 24 Sail of Merchant Ships from the *West-Indies*, who put into *Falmouth* some days ago. This day came in here His Majesty's Ship the *Weymouth*, Capt. *Fumper* Commander, and brought in with him a French Privateer of 12 Guns, 4 Patereroes, and 80 Men, called *La Pucelle* of *St. Malo*, which he took the 6th Instant near *Scilly*.

Bristol, May 29. This day arrived here the *John Ketch* from *Barbadoes*, who came out in company of a Fleet of Merchant Ships under Convoy of the *Tyger* Frigate. The *Greenfish* Store-ship, and the *St. Andrew* from *Rotterdam*, are likewise come in here.

Yarmouth, May 29. Yesterday came into our Road above 60 Sail of Light Colliers, and several others this morning, so that here is now about 120 Sail with their Convoy. The Wind is at present Westerly; if it continues, we may in a day or two expect the laden Fleet from *Newcastle*. The East Country Fleet, being about 30 Sail, are passed by the back of our Sands to the North-East, under Convoy of 4 Men of War.

Yarmouth, May 31. Yesterday morning the *Bonadventure* passed by here with between 60 and 70 Sail of Laden Colliers, without making any stop in this Road, the Wind at N. N. W.

Dunelm, May 30. This morning came into the Downs His Majesty's Ships the *Smirna-Pactor* and *Alorough Ketch*, and about 40 Sail of Coasters under their Convoy; as also the *Bonadventure*. Captain *Price*, from *Antegoa*; The *Isabella*, Captain *Laming*, from *Barbadoes*, and

the *London-Merchant*, Captain *Smith*, from *Virginia*.
