I hereby give notice, pursuant to the 9th Section of the Act 5 & 6 Victoria, cap. 110, intituled "An Act for better preserving the Navigation of the River Mersey," that I have received a notice from Messrs. Grayson and Shephard, Surveyors, 606, Royal Liver Building, Liverpool, on behalf of Messrs. H. and C. Grayson, Limited, Garston, given pursuant to the above mentioned Act, of their intention to construct at Garston a 9" drain in the foreshore of the River Mersey in accordance with plans and sections deposited at this office, a copy of which notice is subjoined.

In pursuance of an Act for better preserving the Navigation of the River Mersey (5 & 6 Vic., cap. 110), we, Grayson and Shephard, Surveyors, 606, Royal Liver Building, Liverpool, on behalf of Messrs. H. and C. Grayson, Limited, Shipbuilders and Engineers, Garston, hereby give you notice that we propose to construct at Garston, in accordance with plans and sections deposited at the Office of the Mersey Conservancy, a 9" drain in the foreshore of the River Mersey, adjoining the river wall of the shipyard belonging to Messrs. H. and C. Grayson, Limited, and the river wall belonging to the London and North Western Railway Company, such drain to discharge into the man-hole over the Garston outfall belonging to the City of Liverpool. The drain will be about 50' 0' long, will be cut in a trench and protected by concrete.

It is proposed to commence the work as soon as permission is given. The drain will be laid in the course of a week, and it will not project into, or exclude, impede or interrupt the tidal or other waters of the River Mersey.
