

"We beg leave humbly to recommend that Your Majesty may be graciously pleased, by Your Order in Council, to sanction the grant to these Officers of the increments of full pay authorized for Confirmed Warrant Officers, Royal Navy, and of pensions and allowances to their widows and children as proposed above.

"The Lords Commissioners of Your Majesty's Treasury have signified their concurrence in this proposal."

His Majesty, having taken the said Memorial into consideration, was pleased, by and with the advice of His Privy Council, to approve of what is therein proposed.

And the Right Honourable the Lords Commissioners of the Admiralty are to give the necessary directions herein accordingly.

WHEREAS by the Isle of Man (War Legislation) Act, 1914, His Majesty has power to extend to the Isle of Man any Act which, in the opinion of His Majesty, was passed for the purpose of meeting any emergency created by the present War, subject to adaptations for the purpose of making the Act applicable to the Isle of Man:

And whereas by Order in Council, dated the 17th day of December, 1914, His Majesty was pleased to order that the Defence of the Realm Consolidation Act, 1914, and the Defence of the Realm (Consolidation) Regulations, 1914, should extend to the Isle of Man, subject to the adaptations therein contained:

And whereas the said Act and Regulations have been amended by certain other Acts and Regulations which said Acts and Regulations have been extended to the Isle of Man by various subsequent Orders in Council, subject to the adaptations therein contained:

And whereas the said Regulations have been further amended by Orders in Council of the 22nd April, 1916; 12th July, 1916; 6th November, 1916; 23rd November, 1916; 29th November, 1916; 10th January, 1917; 24th January, 1917; 6th February, 1917; 16th February, 1917; 23rd February, 1917; 14th April, 1917; 10th May, 1917; 13th June, 1917; 28th June, 1917; 17th July, 1917; 8th August, 1917; 22nd August, 1917; 29th September, 1917; 23rd October, 1917; 16th November, 1917; 21st December, 1917; 2nd January, 1918; 16th January, 1918; 5th February, 1918; 27th February, 1918; 27th April, 1918; 18th May, 1918; 25th June, 1918; 19th July, 1918; 2nd August, 1918; and the 4th September, 1918:

Now, therefore, His Majesty is pleased, by and with the advice of His Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, that the Regulations amending the Defence of the Realm (Consolidation) Regulations, 1914, made by Orders of His Majesty in Council dated the 22nd April, 1916; 12th July, 1916; 6th November, 1916; 23rd November, 1916; 29th November, 1916; 10th January, 1917; 24th January, 1917; 6th February, 1917; 16th February, 1917; 23rd February, 1917; 14th April, 1917; 10th May, 1917; 13th June, 1917; 28th June, 1917; 17th July, 1917; 8th August, 1917; 22nd August, 1917; 29th September, 1917; 23rd October, 1917; 16th November, 1917; 21st December, 1917; 2nd January, 1918; 16th January, 1918; 5th February, 1918; 27th February, 1918; 27th April, 1918; 18th May, 1918; 25th June, 1918; 19th July, 1918; 2nd August, 1918; and the 4th September, 1918, shall extend to the Isle of Man to the extent specified in the second column of the Schedule hereto, and subject to the adaptations mentioned in the third column of such Schedule.
