ORDER OF THE REGISTRAR-GENERAL
IN ENGLAND.

(Dated 18th December, 1918.)

Whereas by the 21st Section of the Births and Deaths Registration Act, 1874, it is enacted that the Registrar-General, with the sanction of the Local Government Board, may from time to time alter Registration Sub-districts:—

1. And whereas it is expedient in order that the Registration District of Bristol may be made co-extensive with the Parish and City and County Borough of Bristol, as extended by the Bristol Corporation Act, 1918, which came into operation on 1st October, 1918, that

(1) the part of the parish and County Borough of Bristol which, prior to that date, formed part of the parish of Henbury, should be transferred from Almondsbury Sub-district of Thornbury Registration District to Westbury-on-Trym Sub-district of Bristol Registration District; and

(2) the part of the parish and County Borough of Bristol which, prior to the same

date, formed part of the parish of Easton in Gordano should be transferred from St. George Sub-district of Long Ashton Registration District to Bedminster Sub-district of Bristol Registration District;

2. Now, therefore, I, Sir Bernard Mallet, K.C.B., Registrar-General of Births, Deaths, and Marriages in England, in exercise of the powers given me by the above-mentioned Act, and with the sanction of the Local Government Board, do hereby order and declare that the foregoing alteration shall take effect accordingly.

3. This Order shall come into operation on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and Nineteen.

ORDER OF THE REGISTRAR-GENERAL
IN ENGLAND.

(Dated 17th December, 1918.)

Whereas by the 21st Section of the Births and Deaths Registration Act, 1874, it is enacted that the Registrar-General, with the sanction of the Local Government Board, may from time to time alter Registration Sub-districts:—

1. And whereas it is expedient that North Meols Parish should be transferred from North Meols Sub-district of Ormskirk Registration District to Tarleton Sub-district of the same Registration District, and that North Meols Sub-district as thus reduced should be re-named Southport Sub-District;

2. Now, therefore, I, Sir Bernard Mallet, K.C.B., Registrar-General of Births, Deaths, and Marriages in England, in exercise of the powers given me by the above-mentioned Act, and with the sanction of the Local Government Board, do hereby order and declare that the foregoing alteration shall take effect accordingly.

3. This Order shall come into operation on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and Nineteen.
