The KING'S Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

WHEREAS the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England have, in pursuance of the Act of the 7th and 8th years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, Chapter 94, of the Act of the 13th and 14th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 94, and of the Act of the 32nd and 33rd years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 94, duly prepared, and laid before His Majesty in Council, a Scheme or Representation, bearing date the 14th day of November, 1918, in the words and figures following, that is to say:—

"We, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting under the provisions of the Act of the 7th and 8th years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, Chapter 94, of the Act of the 13th and 14th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 94, and of the Act of the 32nd and 33rd years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 94, have prepared, and row humbly lay before Your Majesty in Council; the fol-

lowing Scheme or Representation for altering the boundaries of the New Parish of Saint Bartholomew, Tosside, in the County of York and in the Diocese of Ripon:

"Whereas by the authority of an Order of Her said late Majesty in Council, bearing date the 29th day of November, 1870, and published in the London Gazette on the same day, a District Chapelry was assigned to the consecrated Church of Saint Bartholomew, situate at Tosside, in the Parish of Gisburn, in the said County of York and in the said Diocese of Ripon, and the said District Chapelry was named 'The District Chapelry of Saint Bartholomew, Tosside':

"And whereas the said District Chapelry of Saint Bartholomew, Tosside, has under the provisions of the Act of the 19th and 20th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 104, become a New Parish of the character contemplated by that Act, by the Act of the 6th and 7th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 37, and by the above-mentioned Act of the 32nd and 33rd years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 94:

"And whereas it has been represented to us, and it appears to us to be expedient, that the boundaries of the said New Parish of Saint
