

(B) Ramie stockings and ramie fabrics suitable for the manufacture of gas mantles;

(A) Ranges, cooking and their component parts;

(B) Rubber gloves, surgical;

(B) Rubber (raw, waste and reclaimed), solutions containing rubber, jellies containing rubber, and any other preparations containing rubber, and also balata, gutta-percha, and the following varieties of rubber, viz.:—Borneo, Guayule, Jelutong, Palembang, Pontianac, and all other substances containing caoutchouc;

(B) Sparking plugs;

(A) Stoves, heating, capable of consuming coal, coke or other solid fuel, and their component parts;

(A) Tobacco, unmanufactured and manufactured, except cigars and snuffs;

(B) Tyres for motor vehicles and for motor cycles (whether attached to a vehicle or cycle or not) together with articles and materials especially adapted for use in the manufacture or repair of tyres;

(A) Vices.

(2) That the following heading should be added:—

(A) Guanos, except whale guano.

Now, therefore, their Lordships, having taken the said recommendation into consideration, are pleased to order, and it is hereby ordered, that the same be approved.

Whereof the Commissioners of His Majesty's Customs and Excise, the Director of the War Trade Department, and all other persons whom it may concern, are to take notice and govern themselves accordingly.
