CORN PRODUCTION ACT, 1917. AGRICULTURAL WAGES BOARD (ENGLAND AND WALES).

DETERMINATIONS OF THE VALUES OF "BENEFITS AND ADVANTAGES."

The values at which the provision by an employer for a workman employed by him of the "Benefits and Advantages" specified in the Order of the Agricultural Wages Board (England and Wales), dated the 6th of September, 1918, may be reckoned as payment of wages in lieu of payment in cash for the purpose of any minimum rates of wages fixed under the above Act, have been ascertained and determined in accordance with the terms of the above-mentioned Order as follows :—
