ORDER.

SECOND-HAND RAILWAY WAGONS.

In reference to the following Order made by the Minister of Munitions, namely:—

The Railway Material (Second-hand) Order, 1916, dated the 29th December, 1916, which was by the Railway Material (Second-hand) (Partial Suspension) Order, 1919, dated the 7th February, 1919, suspended until further notice except in so far as related to wagons of all types, the Minister of Munitions hereby orders as follows:—

(1) The operation of the Railway Material (Second-hand) Order, 1916, is hereby suspended until further notice in so far as relates to wagons of all types.

(2) Such suspension shall not affect the previous operation of the said Order or the validity of any action taken thereunder, or the liability to any penalty or punishment in respect of any contravention or failure to comply with the said Order prior to such suspension or any proceeding or remedy in respect of such penalty or punishment.

(3) This Order may be cited as The Railway Material (Second-hand) (Suspension No. 2) Order, 1919.
