Commencing at the post marking the boundary between Bedfordshire and Hertfordshire on the south-western side of the Luton to St. Albans road opposite the road leading to Chiltern Green Railway Station, and proceeding thence in a north-westerly direction along the county boundary to its intersection with the road running along the north-western side of the kennels of the Hertfordshire Foxhounds; thence in south-westerly, south-easterly and southerly directions along the north-western, south-western and western sides of the said road via Kinsbourne Green to its junction with the road leading from Annable's Farm to Harrow Public House; thence in an easterly direction along the northern side of the latter road to where it joins the Luton to St. Albans road; thence in a south-easterly direction along the south-western boundary of the latter road to the gravel pit adjacent to the road leading to Thrales End; thence in a northerly direction across the Luton to St. Albans road to the eastern side of the Thrales End road, thence along the eastern side of the latter road to its intersection with the county boundary; thence in south-westerly and north-westerly directions along the county boundary to the point of commencement.

CORN PRODUCTION ACT, 1917.

The Board of Agriculture and Fisheries hereby give notice, that they propose, after the expiration of forty days from the date of this notice, to make Regulations under the Corn Production Act, 1917 (7 & 8 Geo. 5, Ch. 46), with respect to the claims for payment under Part 1 of that Act or any amendment of that enactment.

Copies of the draft Regulations may be obtained at the Office of the Board, 3, St. James's Square, S. W. 1.

Draft Regulations made by the Board of Agriculture and Fisheries under the Corn Production Act, 1917 (7 & 8 Geo. 5, Ch. 46), with respect to the claims for payment under Part 1 of that Act or any amendment of that enactment.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 12 of the Corn Production Act, 1917, the Board of Agriculture and Fisheries hereby make the following regulations with respect to the manner in which claims for payment under Part 1 of that Act or any amendment of that enactment are to be made to, and determined by, the Board.

1. All such claims for payment shall be made in the form shown in the Schedule to these Regulations or to the like effect.

2. All such claims shall be made to the Board of Agriculture and Fisheries or to a person duly authorized by the Board for that purpose not later than the 30th September, 1919.

3. If in any case it appears to the Board of Agriculture and Fisheries that any land, in respect of which a claim is made, has been negligently cultivated, and the Board propose, by reason thereof, either to withhold altogether the payment to which the person making the claim would otherwise have been entitled or to diminish the amount of such payment, the Board shall give notice thereof in writing to such person, and shall consider any objections thereto, which he may make to the Board within fourteen days from the date of such notice, before they determine the claim.
