preference shares or stock as limited by the existing Acts of the Company, or any of them, and otherwise to amend the provisions of the said Acts, or any of them, so far as may be necessary for any of the purposes aforesaid.

To make new provisions as to the mode of issue of any shares, stock or debenture stock to be issued by the Company under the powers of any existing Act or of any future Act, and to enable the Company to offer any such shares, stock or debenture stock to employees and to consumers of water supplied by them, and, subject thereto, to require the Company to issue such shares, stock and debenture stock, or such of them as may be specified in the Order by selling the same by auction or by tender, and to repeal, alter or amend the provisions of any such existing Act relating to the mode of issue of shares, stock or debenture stock, and as to the sale of shares, stock or debenture stock by auction or tender.

To vary and extinguish all rights and privileges which will or may interfere with any of its objects, and confer other rights and privileges.

To alter, amend, extend or repeal, so far as may be necessary for the purposes of the Order, the provisions, or some of the provisions, of the West Hampshire Water Acts. 1893, 1902 and 1913.

On or before the 11th day of June instant a copy of this notice, as published in the London Gazette, will be deposited for public inspection with the Clerk of the Peace for the County of Hampshire at his office at The Castle, Winchester, and at the office of the Board of Trade, Whitehall Gardens, London, S.W. 1
