COUNTY OF THE WEST RIDING OF YORKSHIRE.

*Baildon, Mytholmroyd, Settle, Skipton and
 Tadcaster.*

Notice is hereby given, that the Minister
 of Health by an Order dated the 29th day of
 August, 1919, has made a Regulation under
 Section 9 of the Motor Car Act, 1903, which
 will come into operation on the 1st day of
 October, 1919, limiting to ten miles per hour
 the speed at which a motor car may be driven
 within the limits comprising the under-
 mentioned roads or parts of roads, viz.:—

In the Urban District of Baildon.

So much of Northgate as extends from its
 junction with Browgate to a point in the road
 opposite the Malt Shovel Inn.

Browgate.

So much of Baildon Road as extends from
 its junction with Browgate to its junction with
 Station Road.

Westgate.

Hallcliffe.

So much of Green Road as extends from its
 junction with Baildon Road to a point in the
 road 50 yards south of the School.

In the Urban District of Mytholmroyd.

So much of the Mytholmroyd and Black-
 stone Edge Main Road as extends from its
 junction with the Todmorden, Halifax and
 Burnley Main Road to a point in the centre
 of Scar Bottom Bridge.

*In the Rural District of Settle
 Parish of Settle.*

So much of the Keighley and Kendal Main
 Road as extends from the Post Office to a
 point in the road opposite to the garden of
 the house known as "The Nook."

Parish of Ingleton.

So much of the Lancaster and Richmond
 Main Road as extends from the Police
 Station to the eastern extremity of Ingleton
 Bridge.

The Bank.

So much of Back Gate Road as extends
 from a point in the road 50 yards south-west
 of the Railway Bridge over the road to its
 junction with the Lancaster and Richmond
 Main Road.
