

For delivery to commercial consumers (not for resale) in steel barrels 1d. per gallon less than can price, and for delivery in bulk to commercial consumers (not for resale) 1½d. less than can price. One penny per gallon to be added to all above prices when sold for delivery in Scotland or Ireland.

Maximum Retail Prices

The maximum price at which Motor Spirit may be sold by retail shall be the delivered price per gallon to the retailer, with an addition of fourpence halfpenny a gallon. Quantities less than a gallon shall be sold at a price proportionate to that charged per gallon. Where Motor Spirit is delivered by a retailer to a purchaser at any place other than the retailer's place of business an extra charge at the rate of one penny for a gallon or for any part of a gallon may be added to the price permitted by this Order.
