

the making or trimming of men's, women's or children's headgear from other materials; (c) Warehousing, packing, and other similar operations carried on in shops wholly, mainly, or substantially engaged in the retail distribution of articles of any description that are not made on the premises.

In accordance with the Regulations with respect to the Constitution and Proceedings of the above-mentioned Trade Board dated 25th October, 1919, the Trade Board shall consist of:—
