**RULES PUBLICATION ACT, 1893.**

In conformity with the provisions of the Statute 56 and 57 Vict. cap. 66, Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for India in Council proposes, with the advice and assistance of the Civil Service Commissioners, at the expiration of 40 days from the date of this Gazette, to make under Section 97 of the Statute 5 and 6 George V., cap. 61, alterations as set out below in the Regulations for the admission of candidates to the Indian Civil Service.

For Regulation 5 which now stands as follows:—
