other vehicles, such fares and charges as may be prescribed by the intended Act, to provide (if thought fit) that the omnibus undertaking shall form part of the tramways undertaking of the Corporation, and that the omnibuses or other vehicles shall for purposes of licensing drivers, &c., be deemed to be carriages used on tramways, and to authorize the Corporation to make bye-laws for regulating the travelling and for preventing nuisances in or upon the said omnibuses or other vehicles.

14. To authorize the Corporation to lease the said omnibuses or other vehicles, or any of them, and their powers in connection therewith, to any corporation, company or person for such period or periods as they may think fit, and to enter into agreements as to working the same, whether as part of a through route or
