

At the Court at *Buckingham Palace*, the 22nd day of *January*, 1920.

PRESENT,

The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

WHEREAS by Section 1 of the Burial Act, 1855, it is provided that it shall be lawful for His Majesty, by and with the advice of His Privy Council, from time to time to postpone the time appointed by any Order in Council for the discontinuance of burials, or otherwise to vary any Order in Council made under any of the Acts recited in the said Act, or under the said Act, as to His Majesty, with such advice as aforesaid, may seem fit:

And whereas His Majesty was pleased, by His Order in Council dated the 20th day of August, 1915, to direct the discontinuance forthwith of burials in the Parish Church of St. Andrew, High Ham, in the County of Somerset, and, with certain exceptions, in the Churchyard attached thereto:

And whereas the time appointed by the said Order in Council for the discontinuance of burials in the said Churchyard has been further postponed by Order in Council from time to time, and now stands postponed, by virtue of an Order in Council dated the 14th day of January, 1919, to the 28th day of February, 1920:

And whereas it seems fit to His Majesty, by and with the advice of His Privy Council, that the time for discontinuing burials in the said Churchyard should be further postponed:

Now, therefore, His Majesty, by and with the advice aforesaid, is pleased to order, as it is hereby ordered, that the time appointed for the discontinuance of burials in the Churchyard of the Parish of High Ham, in the County of Somerset, be postponed to the 28th day of August, 1920.

WHEREAS it is provided by Section 2 of the Customs (Exportation Prohibition) Act, 1914, that any Proclamation or Order in Council made under Section 8 of the Customs and Inland Revenue Act, 1879, as amended by the Act now in recital, may, whilst a state of war exists, be varied or added to by an Order made by the Lords of the Council on the recommendation of the Board of Trade:

And whereas it is provided by Section 2 of the Customs (Exportation Restriction) Act, 1914, that any Proclamation made under Section 1 of the Exportation of Arms Act, 1900, may, whether the Proclamation was made before or after the passing of the Act now in recital, be varied or added to, whilst a state of war exists, by an Order made by the Lords of the Council on the recommendation of the Board of Trade:

And whereas by a Proclamation, dated the 10th day of May, 1917, and made under Section 8 of the Customs and Inland Revenue Act, 1879, and Section 1 of the Exportation of Arms Act, 1900, and Section 1 of the Customs (Ex-

portation Prohibition) Act, 1914, the exportation from the United Kingdom of certain articles to certain or all destinations was prohibited:

And whereas by subsequent Orders of Council, and by the Proclamations dated respectively the 18th day of December, 1918, and the 12th day of March, 1919, the said Proclamation was amended and added to in certain particulars:

And whereas there was this day read at the Board a recommendation from the Board of Trade to the following effect:—

That the Proclamation, dated the 10th day of May, 1917, as amended and added to by subsequent Orders of Council and by the Proclamations dated respectively the 18th day of December, 1918, and the 12th day of March, 1919, should be further amended by making the following amendments in and additions to the Schedule to the same:—

(1) That the following headings should be deleted:—

- (B) Accoutrements not otherwise prohibited;
- (B) Barographs suitable for aircraft;
- (A) Heliographs and their component parts;
- (A) Mica blocks, mica sheets and mica splittings;
- (A) Periscopes and their component parts;
- (A) Range finders and their component parts;
- (B) Searchlights and their component parts;
- (B) Submarine sound signalling apparatus;
- (B) Torpedo nets;
- (B) Web equipment;
- (A) Wool, raw, and mixtures thereof;
- (A) Wool noils and wool waste and mixtures thereof;

Provisions and victuals which may be used as food for man or cattle, the following:—

- (A) Buckwheat;
- (A) Cakes and meals which may be used as forage or food for animals, the following:—

Cotton seed cake and cotton seed meal;
Husk meal;
Linseed cake and meal;
Maize germ meal;
Maize meal and flour;

- (A) Copra;
- (A) Cotton seed;
- (A) Feeding stuffs containing molasses;
- (A) Ground nuts;
- (A) Oils and fats, edible, the following:—

Cocoanut oil;
Groundnut oil;
Palmkernel oil;

- (A) Palm kernels;
- (A) Patent and proprietary cattle foods of all kinds;

Chemicals, drugs, dyestuffs, and medicinal and pharmaceutical preparations, the following:—

- (A) Benzol and its compounds and preparations;
- (A) Dimethylaniline;
