The Civil Service Commissioners hereby give notice that the following Regulations are published with the consent of the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury, viz.:—  
SPECIAL REGULATIONS respecting a Competitive Examination for the situation of Woman Clerk (Higher Grade) in the Ministry of Labour.

1. The limits of age for these situations are 25 and 35. Candidates must be of the prescribed age on the first day of March, 1920. A Candidate born on March 1st would be admitted on the 25th but not on the 35th anniversary of her birth.

No exception on any grounds will be made to this rule.

2. No Candidate will be eligible who has not rendered two full years' approved service prior to the 1st March, 1920, in an established or temporary post in one or more of His Majesty's Civil Departments, or as an enrolled member in the clerical sections of Queen Mary's Army Auxiliary Corps, the Women's Royal Naval Service, the Women's Royal Air Force, or the Voluntary Aid Detachments General Service, or in a temporary clerical post in the War Department Establishments, or in National Factories, Stores, Bonds, Depots, &c., where the services were remunerated direct from public funds.
