

Thame to Long Crendon opposite St. Mary's Church at Thame; thence along that road to the county boundary by Thame Bridge, thence in a westerly direction along the north bank of the River Thame to the point where the county boundary first leaves the river, thence in a northerly direction along the county boundary to the point where it is joined by the eastern boundary of Shabbington parish, thence along that parish boundary in northerly, north-westerly, and south-westerly directions to the point where that boundary crosses the road from Shabbington to Worminghall, thence in a north-westerly direction along that road to Lappingford Bridge, Worminghall, thence along the western bound-

dary of Ickford parish in a south-westerly direction until it meets the River Thame, thence along that river in a westerly and south-easterly direction to Waterstock Mill, thence southerly along the road leading from the Mill to Great Milton to its point of intersection with the road from Wheatley to Tetworth, thence in a south-easterly direction along the latter road to the point of commencement.

### INCOME TAX.

### ORDER OF THE REGISTRAR-GENERAL IN ENGLAND.

(Dated 13th March, 1920.)

Whereas by the 21st Section of the Births and Deaths Registration Act, 1874, and Section 3 of the Ministry of Health Act, 1919, it is enacted that the Registrar-General, with the sanction of the Minister of Health, may from time to time alter Registration Sub-Districts:—

1. And whereas it is expedient in the interest of public convenience and in order that so far as possible no Ward of that part of the City and County Borough of Birmingham situated in Birmingham Union should be divided for Registration purposes, that the constituent Registration Districts and Sub-Districts of that Union should be re-arranged in the following manner, viz.:—

(a) *King's Norton Registration District*:—

- (1) King's Norton Sub-District to consist of King's Norton, Moseley and King's Heath, Northfield, and Selly Oak Wards;
- (2) Balsall Heath Sub-District to consist of Balsall Heath Ward;
