ORDER OF THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

(DATED 18TH MARCH 1920.)

GLoucestershire AND DISTRICT (FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE) ORDER OF 1920 (No. 7).

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1914, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

Withdrawal of Restrictions from Parts of Scheduled District.

1. The restrictions on the movement of animals imposed by the Gloucestershire and District (Foot-and-Mouth Disease) Order of 1920, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Order, shall apply only to the Contracted Prohibited Area described in the Schedule hereto, and that Area shall be the Scheduled District for the purposes of the principal Order, which shall apply thereto without modification.

Revocation of Orders.

2. The Gloucestershire and District (Foot-and-Mouth Disease) Orders of 1920 (Nos. 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6) are hereby revoked.
