COMPANIES WINDING-UP RULES, 1920.

1 The following Rule shall be inserted in the Companies (Winding-Up) Rules, 1909, as Rule 184B.

184B —The total of any items of costs (as distinct from payments) in respect of business done after the 31st day of December, 1919, in a winding-up in a County Court, shall be increased by $33\frac{1}{3}$ per centum, and such increase shall be allowed upon any taxation of costs whether as between Party and Party or as between Solicitor and Client.

Provided (a) that this Rule shall not apply to items in respect of business the remuneration for which is regulated by the General Order made in pursuance of the Solicitors' Remuneration Act, 1881, or by the Solicitors' Remuneration Act General Order, 1919.

(b) that this Rule shall not affect the power to direct payment of a sum in lieu of costs under Order 65, Rule 23, of the Rules of the Supreme Court, or the power to allow a fixed sum for costs under Order 65, Rule 27 (38) of the said Rules, or a gross sum under Order 65, Rule 27 (38a) of the said Rules, and

(c) that this Rule shall not apply to Bills of costs which have at the date on which this Rule comes into operation already been delivered to the Official Receiver or Liquidator for taxation or delivered to a client sought to be charged therewith, or to the person chargeable therewith or liable therefor, or to Bills then already taxed and certified or allowed

Rule 184A is hereby revoked except in respect of business done before the 1st day of January, 1920, and except as regards those Bills of Costs which are excluded from the operation of this Rule by the last preceding proviso to this Rule.

The increase hereby authorised shall not affect the question whether a Bill of Costs when taxed is or is not less by one-sixth part than the bill delivered sent or left

THE WILD BIRDS PROTECTION (ADMINISTRATIVE COUNTY OF WEST SUFFOLK) ORDER, 1920. DATED MARCH 26, 1920.

In pursuance of the powers conferred on me by the Wild Birds Protection Acts, 1880 to 1908, and upon application by the Council of the Administrative County of West Suffolk, I hereby make the following Order:—

Title.

I. This Order may be cited as "The Wild Birds Protection (Administrative County of West Suffolk) Order, 1920."

BIRDS.

Additions to the Schedule of the Act of 1880.

II. The Wild Birds Protection Act, 1880, shall apply within the Administrative County of West Suffolk to the following species of Wild Birds in the same manner as if those species were included in the Schedule to the Act:—
