ORDER OF THE MINISTER OF
AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

(DATED 10TH MAY, 1920.)

NORFOLK (FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE) ORDER
OF 1920 (No. 5).

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1914, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

Contraction of Scheduled District.

1. The Norfolk (Foot-and-Mouth Disease) Order of 1920 and the Norfolk (Foot-and-Mouth Disease) Order of 1920 (No. 3) shall apply only to the Area described in the Schedule to the Norfolk (Foot-and-Mouth Disease) Order of 1920 (No. 4), which shall continue to be a Prohibited Area for the purposes of the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Control of Movement) Order of 1920.

Commencement.

2. This Order shall come into operation on the twelfth day of May, nineteen hundred and twenty.

Short Title.

3. This Order may be cited as the Norfolk (Foot-and-Mouth Disease) Order of 1920 (No. 5), and shall be read with the Orders referred to in Article 1.
