APPOINTMENTS.

In two portions, viz.:—

DEAN BRADLEY STREET,
Westminster.

Two carriages.

Commencing at Eastern end of Dean Bradley Street, and extending along centre of road. Front of vehicles facing St. John's Church.

Horse Guards Avenue, Whitehall. Sixteen carriages.

First portion: —For eight carriages, commencing at the Eastern end of War Office Buildings, and extending Westward along centre of road. Front of vehicles facing East.

Second portion:—For eight carriages, commencing at the Western side of gates leading to War Office, and extending Westward along centre of road. Front of vehicles facing East.

The first portion of the Standing to be fed exclusively by carriages from the second portion.
