AERIAL LIGHTHOUSE AT BRON.

It is hereby notified that:—

An Aerial Lighthouse has been installed at the South-Eastern boundary of Bron Aerodrome (Lyons) in a position approximately 45° 44' North Latitude, 4° 53' East Longitude.

This Lighthouse exhibits a green light and flashes the letter "H" of the Morse Code once every 7½ seconds, thus:—Flash ½ second, eclipse ½ second; flash ½ second, eclipse ½
