CORN PRODUCTION ACT, 1917. AGRICULTURAL WAGES BOARD. (ENGLAND AND WALES.)

SPECIAL RATES OF WAGES FIXED FOR THE CORN HARVEST IN SUFFOLK.

The Agricultural Wages Board (England and Wales) hereby give Notice, as required by the above Act, that they have made the following Order as regards the wages of male and female workers employed on the Corn Harvest, in the area comprising the administrative counties of East Suffolk and West Suffolk and the county borough of Ipswich so as to provide as follows, that is to say:—

1. During the period of corn harvest no employment on harvest work on a weekday shall be treated as overtime employment, and every worker employed on harvest work shall be entitled to wages at the ordinary rate applicable to a worker of his or her age and sex, under the Orders of the Wages Board for the time being in force, and shall also be entitled to be paid (as part of his or her wages) on the completion of harvest the sum mentioned in the following Table, if he or she has worked throughout the period of harvest, and to a due proportion of that sum if he or she has worked a part only of that period, provided that the said wages shall be payable for hours of work, which during the period of the harvest shall, if required, be not less than 12 hours on any weekday while the crops are being carted, and not less than 11 hours on any weekday while other harvest work is in progress.

CORN PRODUCTION ACT, 1917. AGRICULTURAL WAGES BOARD (ENGLAND AND WALES).

SPECIAL RATES OF WAGES FIXED FOR THE PERIOD OF CORN HARVEST IN ESSEX.

The Agricultural Wages Board (England and Wales) hereby give Notice, as required by the above Act, that they have made the following Order as regards the wages payable during the period of the corn harvest to certain male and female workers employed in agriculture in the area comprising the administrative county of Essex, the county boroughs of East Ham, Southend-on-Sea, and West Ham, and those parts of the metropolitan borough of Woolwich, in the administrative county of London, which lie north of the River Thames.

1. During the period of the corn harvest the following provision shall apply in the case of farms comprising more than 50 acres of corn:—

No employment on harvest work on a week-day shall be treated as overtime employment, and every worker employed on harvest work shall be entitled to wages at the ordinary rate applicable to a worker of his or her age and sex under any Order of the Wages Board for the time being in force, and shall also be entitled to be paid (as part of his or her wages) on the completion of harvest the sum mentioned in the Schedule to this Order, if he or she has worked throughout the period of harvest, and to a due proportion of that sum if he or she has worked a part only of that period, provided that the said wages shall be payable for hours of work, which during the period of the harvest shall, if required, be not less than 12 hours on any week-day while the crops are being carted, and not less than 11 hours on any week-day while other harvest work is in progress.

2. In the case of a farm comprising not more than 50 acres of corn, during a period of 4 weeks from the commencement of the corn harvest on that farm no employment on a weekday (whether on harvest work or not) shall be treated as overtime employment, and every worker (whether employed on harvest work or not) shall be entitled to the wages mentioned in the foregoing clause (including the sum payable under the Schedule to this
