THE PROFITEERING ACTS, 1919 AND 1920, ORDER (No. 10), DATED JULY 2ND, 1920, MADE BY THE BOARD OF TRADE UNDER SECTION 1 OF THE PROFITEERING ACT, 1919 (9 & 10 GEO. 5, c. 66), AS AMENDED BY THE PROFITEERING (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1920 (10 & 11 GEO. 5, c. 13).

Whereas Section 1 of the Profiteering Act, 1919 (9 & 10 Geo. 5, c. 66), as amended by the Profiteering (Amendment) Act, 1920 (10 & 11 Geo. 5, c. 13), provides that that Section may be applied by Order of the Board of Trade to any article or class of articles being an article or class of articles declared by the Order to be one or one of a kind in common use by the public or being material, machinery or accessories used in the production thereof;

Now, therefore, the Board of Trade do hereby declare that the articles set out in the Schedule annexed hereto are articles of a kind in common use by the public, and do hereby order that Section 1 of the Profiteering Act, 1919 (9 & 10 Geo. 5, c. 66), as amended by the Profiteering (Amendment) Act, 1920 (10 & 11 Geo. 5, c. 13) shall apply to each article or class of articles mentioned in the Schedule hereto.

This Order shall come into force as from the fifth day of July, 1920, and may be cited as the Profiteering Acts, 1919 and 1920, Order (No. 10).

PROPOSAL TO VARY GENERAL MINIMUM TIME-RATES AND OVERTIME RATES FOR CERTAIN CLASSES OF MALE AND FEMALE WORKERS.

In accordance with Regulations made under Section 18 of the Trade Boards Act, 1909, by the Minister of Labour, and dated 31st October, 1918, the Trade Board established in Scotland under the Trade Boards Act, 1918, for the Aerated Waters Trade, as specified in the Trade Boards (Aerated Waters) Order, 1919, hereby give notice as required by Section 3 (5) of the Trade Boards Act, 1918 (the Minister of Labour having given his consent to such Notice being given), that they Propose to Vary the General Minimum Time-Rates and Overtime Rates as set out in their Notice dated 11th June, 1920, in their application to certain classes of Male and Female Workers, the proposed variation of the Minimum Rates of Wages being as shown in the Schedule set out below:—

SCHEDULE.

PART I.

Proposed Variation of General Minimum Time-Rates for Certain Classes of Male and Female Workers.

SECTION I.

For Male Workers of 21 years of age and over, from 1s. 2d. per hour to 1s. 3d. per hour.

SECTION II.

For Female Workers of 18 years of age and over, with not less than six months' experience in the trade, from 7½d. per hour to 8d. per hour.

PART II.

Proposed Variation of Overtime Rates for Certain Classes of Male and Female Workers.

Overtime Rates calculated on the General Minimum Time-Rates specified in Part I of this Schedule, in the manner set out in Part II of the Schedule to the Notice issued by the Trade Board, dated 11th June, 1920, fixing Minimum Rates of Wages for Male and Female Workers, shall apply in substitution for the General Minimum Time-Rates set out in Part I of this Schedule in respect of hours worked in excess of the number of hours declared by the Trade Board, in the said Notice dated 11th June, 1920, to be the normal number of hours of work in the trade.

PART III.

The above minimum rates of wages shall apply subject to the provisions of the Trade Boards Acts and of this notice, to all workers in Scotland who are employed during the whole
