LANDING LIGHTS AT BORDEAUX AERODROME.

*It is hereby notified that:—*The landing lights at Bordeaux Aerodrome
as described in Notice to Airmen No. 28 of
24th March, 1920, are only exhibited when
aircraft are expected.Pilots intending to land at Bordeaux at
night should therefore communicate direct
with the Commandant, whose telegraphic
address is:—Commandant,
Aero Merignac,
Bordeaux.It is not necessary to advise the Comman-
dant beforehand when landing in the day.Attention is drawn to Notice to Airmen
No. 66 of 7th June, 1920, under which all
aeroplanes entering France from England must
first land at either St. Inglevert or La Bourget
Aerodrome.Notice to Airmen No. 69 of June 18th is
