(FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE: INFECTED PLACE.)

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1914, and of every power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

hereto are hereby declared to be a place infected with Foot-and-Mouth Disease.

Description and Limits of Infected Place.
