

Master and Fellows; nor shall any goods or property of the College be sold, exchanged, or alienated without the consent of a majority of the Master and Fellows.

#### 27. *The Dean of College.*

The Dean of College shall be responsible for the maintenance of discipline over the members of the College *in statu pupillari*. He shall be appointed by the Master and Fellows for such period or periods as they shall from time to time determine. He shall be paid a stipend to be fixed by the Master and Fellows. He may be deprived of his office for grave cause by a vote of two-thirds of the Master and Fellows present at a special meeting called for the purpose.

#### 28. *The Dean of Chapel.*

The Dean of Chapel shall be in Holy Orders and shall be responsible for the due conduct of divine service in the College Chapel and for the religious instruction of all members of the College *in statu pupillari* belonging to the Established Church. He shall be appointed by the Master and Fellows for such period or periods as they shall from time to time determine. He shall be paid a stipend to be fixed by the Master and Fellows. He may be deprived of his office for grave cause by a vote of two-thirds of the Master and Fellows present at a special meeting called for the purpose.

#### 29. *The Librarian.*

When there is a vacancy in the office of Librarian, the Master may, if he think fit, nominate one of the Fellows for a probationary period of three years, and on the expiration of such period the Master and Fellows may confirm the appointment from time to time for such period or periods as may seem to them fit. In the event of the Master declining to nominate, the appointment for the probationary period shall be made by the Master and Fellows not necessarily from among the Fellows. He shall be paid a stipend to be fixed by the Master and Fellows after his nomination or election.

The Librarian shall observe the rules prescribed by the Master and Fellows for the discharge of his office. He may be deprived of his office for grave cause by a vote of two-thirds of the Master and Fellows present at a special meeting called for the purpose.

#### 30. *The Educational Staff.*

The Educational Staff of the College shall consist of a Tutor or Tutors, Assistant Tutors, Directors of Studies, Lecturers, Assistant Lecturers and Supervisors of Studies, the number of each being determined from time to time by the Master and Fellows.

When there is a vacancy in the office of Tutor, the Master may, if he think fit, nominate one of the Fellows for a probationary period of three years, and on the expiration of such period the Master and Fellows may confirm the appointment from time to time for such period or periods as may seem to them fit. In the event of the Master declining to nominate, the appointment for the probationary period shall be made by the Master and Fellows, not necessarily from among the Fellows. He shall be paid a stipend to be fixed by the Master and Fellows after his nomination or election. If at any time in the judgment of the Master and Fellows a Tutor shall appear to be incompetent or to have neglected

his duties, it shall be lawful for them by a vote, in which two-thirds of the whole body concur, passed at a special meeting called for the purpose, to deprive him of his office.

The Assistant Tutors, Directors of Studies, Lecturers, Assistant Lecturers, and Supervisors of Studies shall be appointed by the Master and Fellows for such period or periods as they shall from time to time determine.

The Master and Fellows shall fix from time to time the stipends to be paid to the members of the Educational Staff, and also the Tuition Fees to be paid by Students of the College.

#### 31. *The Caution Money.*

All Caution Money shall be received by some officer appointed by the Master and Fellows for the purpose. It shall be placed to the credit of a fund to be called the Caution Fund.

The Caution Fund shall be managed and the income thereof applied in such manner as the Master and Fellows shall direct. The accounts of it shall be audited annually with the other accounts of the College. The Master and Fellows may at any time direct that a portion of the Caution Fund be placed in the hands of a Tutor.

#### 32. *The Bible Clerks and Scholars.*

The Bible Clerks and Scholars shall be of good character and sufficient learning, and shall be elected by the Master and Fellows.

The Bible Clerks shall perform such duties in connection with the Chapel as may be assigned to them by the Master and Fellows.

The Bible Clerks and Scholars shall conduct themselves with propriety and approve themselves to the Master and Fellows by their industry and progress; in the event of any failure to observe this statute, it shall be lawful for the Master and Fellows to deprive a Bible Clerk or Scholar of his emoluments.

No scholar shall retain his scholarship after he is of standing to take the degree of Master of Arts or other equivalent degree.

No one shall be allowed to compete for a scholarship before commencing residence in the University if his age exceeds nineteen years on October 1st preceding the examination. The tenure of such scholarships shall be for not more than two years in the first instance subject to good conduct and diligence and progress, and the maximum emolument shall be £80 inclusive of rent of rooms and all allowances.

#### 33. *College Discipline.*

The Bible Clerks, Scholars, and all members of the College *in statu pupillari* shall pay due respect and obedience to the Master and other officers of the College; they shall conduct themselves quietly and with decorum; and shall observe the Statutes and all rules made from time to time for the government of the College.

If any person *in statu pupillari* fails to observe the said Statutes and rules, or commits any offence against good behaviour and the discipline of the College, he shall be punished by the Master or the Dean of College or other officer of the College. But no one shall be removed from the College whether for a time or permanently, or be deprived of his emoluments, except by a vote of the Master and Fellows at a special meeting called for the purpose of considering the question.
