The borough of Chippenham, the petty sessional divisions of Melksham, Trowbridge and Bradford, and the parishes of Box, Colerne, Slaughterford, Biddestone, Corsham, Chippenham Without (including its detached part), Hardenhuish, Lacock, Pewsham, Langley Burrell Without, and Kella-ways; and

In the administrative county of Somerset:

The petty sessional division of Frome (*except the parish of Leigh-upon-Mendip*), the parishes of Hardington, Hemington, Hinton Charterhouse, Freshford, and such portions of the parish of Wellow as lie to the south and east of the railway from Radstock to Bath.

(FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE: INFECTED PLACE.)

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1914, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

1. The premises mentioned in the Schedule hereto shall cease to be a Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Place
2. This Order shall come into operation on the twenty-ninth day of September, nineteen hundred and twenty.

(MUZZLING AND CONTROL OF DOGS) ORDER OF 1920 (No. 2).

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1914, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

Prohibition of Movement of Dogs out of Inner Controlled Area.

1. No dog shall be moved out of the Area described in the Schedule hereto (hereinafter
