#### DEFENCE OF THE REALM.

THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES (GAS AND COAL)  
 (SCOTLAND) ORDER, 1920, DATED OCTOBER  
 16, 1920, MADE BY THE SECRETARY FOR SCOT-  
 LAND UNDER REGULATIONS 2J AND 2JJ OF THE  
 DEFENCE OF THE REALM REGULATIONS.

In pursuance of the powers conferred on  
 me by Regulation 2J as read with Regulation  
 2JJ of the Defence of the Realm Regulations  
 and by arrangement with the Board of Trade,  
 I hereby order as follows:—

(1) In this Order the expression "Local  
 Authority" shall mean the Council of a County  
 or Burgh or any District Committee to which  
 a County Council shall delegate its powers  
 under the Coal (Emergency) Order, 1920.

(2) I hereby confer and impose upon the  
 Local Authority and upon such of their officers  
 as they may designate or appoint for the pur-  
 pose the powers and duties necessary to provide  
 for the due discharge within their district, in  
 conformity with the Defence of the Realm  
 Regulations, of the functions assigned to Local  
 Authorities by the Gas and Coal (Emergency)  
 Order, 1920, the Lighting, Heating and Power
