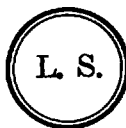

ORDER OF THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

(DATED 26TH NOVEMBER 1920.)

KENT (FAVERSHAM DISTRICT) (FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE) ORDER OF 1920 (No. 12).

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1914, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

Further Contraction of Scheduled District.

1. The Kent (Faversham District) (Foot-and-Mouth Disease) Order of 1920 (No. 7) shall apply only to the Area described in the Schedule to this Order, and that Area, subject to the modification contained in Article 2 of the first-mentioned Order, shall be a Prohibited Area for the purposes of the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Control of Movement) Order of 1920.

2. This Order shall come into operation on the twenty-ninth day of November, nineteen hundred and twenty.

3. This Order may be cited as the KENT (FAVERSHAM DISTRICT) (FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE) ORDER OF 1920 (No. 12), and shall be read with the Kent (Faversham District) (Foot-and-Mouth Disease) Order of 1920 (No. 7).
