BERKSHIRE AND DISTRICT (MUZZLING AND CONTROL OF DOGS)
ORDER OF 1920 (No. 5).

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1914, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

Withdrawal of Requirement of Leading in Inner Controlled Area.

1. Where under Article 2 (*Control and Muzzling of Dogs in certain Inner Controlled Area*) of the Berkshire and District (Muzzling and Control of Dogs) Order of 1920 (No. 2) a dog is required to be efficiently muzzled with an effective wire cage muzzle, and also to be led by a person with a collar and chain or other attachment, it shall be deemed sufficient compliance with the provisions of that Article if the dog is efficiently muzzled with a wire cage muzzle without being also led.

Local Authority to Enforce Order.

2. The provisions of this Order shall be executed and enforced by the Local Authority.

Commencement.

3. This Order shall come into operation on the eleventh day of December, nineteen hundred and twenty.

Short Title.

4. This Order may be cited as the BERKSHIRE AND DISTRICT (MUZZLING AND CONTROL OF DOGS) ORDER OF 1920 (No. 5).

SUFFOLK (FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE) ORDER OF 1920 (No. 6).

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1914, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

Contraction of Scheduled District.

1. The Suffolk (Foot-and-Mouth Disease) Order of 1920 shall apply only to the Area described in the Schedule to this Order, and that Area, subject to the modification contained in Article 2 of the first-mentioned Order, shall be a Prohibited Area for the purposes of the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Control of Movement) Order of 1920.

2. This Order shall come into operation on the ninth day of December, nineteen hundred and twenty.

3. This Order may be cited as the SUFFOLK (FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE) ORDER OF 1920 (No. 6), and shall be read with the Suffolk (Foot-and-Mouth Disease) Order of 1920 and the Suffolk (Foot-and-Mouth Disease) Order of 1920 (No. 2).

SCHEDULE.

Prohibited Area referred to in this Order.

An Area in the administrative county of East Suffolk, comprising the parishes of Clopton, Debach, Dallinghoo, Dallinghoo Wild, Pettistree, Ufford, Gredfield, Boulge, Burgh, Grundisburgh, Culpho, Tuddenham, Rushmere St. Andrew, Playford, Little Bealings, Great Bealings, Hasketon, Melton, Bromeswell, Eyke, Sutton, Woodbridge, Martlesham, Kesgrave, Purdis Farm, Foxhall, Brightwell, Waldringfield, Shottisham, Ramsholt, Hemley, Newbourn, Bucklesham, Alresbourn Priory, Nacton, Levington, Stratton Hall, Trimley St. Martin, Trimley St. Mary, Falkenham, Felixstowe and Kirton.
