Notice of Proposal to Vary the Minimum Rates of Wages at Present in Force for Male Workers of certain Ages through-QUT England and Wales.

The Agricultural Wages Board (England and Wales) hereby give notice, as required by

the above Act, that they propose to vary their - Orders of the 21st May and 7th July, 1920, so as to provide that in the areas hereunder mentioned the minimum rates of wages payable to male workers of the respective classes and ages specified below for employment in agriculture for a week consisting of the hours of employment specified in the said Orders in relation to such areas and classes respectively and the differential rates for overtime employment shall, as from the 1st March, 1921, be as follows:—
