### GAS REGULATION ACT, 1920.

Notice of Application by the Aldershot Gas, Water and District Lighting Company for an Order under Section 1 of the Gas Regulation Act, 1920.

**N**OTICE is hereby given, that the Aldershot Gas, Water and District Lighting Company (hereinafter referred to as "the Undertakers") have applied to the Board of Trade under the provisions of section 1 of the Gas Regulation Act, 1920, for an Order providing for:—

(a) The repeal of any enactments or other provisions requiring the Undertakers to supply gas of any particular illuminating value and the substitution thereof of power to charge for thermal units supplied in the form of gas, and

(b) The modification of the statutory or other provisions affecting the charges which may be made by the Undertakers by substituting for the standard price per 1,000 cubic feet of gas now authorized, with an addition to meet increases in the costs and charges of and incidental to the production and supply of gas by the Undertakers since the 30th June, 1914, standard prices for each therm (*i.e.*, 100,000 British Thermal Units).

The standard prices now authorized as aforesaid, and the standard prices per therm which the Undertakers have asked the Board of Trade to substitute therefor in accordance with paragraph (b) above, are as follows:—

(i) In the area of supply of the Undertakers as it existed prior to the passing of the Aldershot Gas and Water Act, 1896, for the standard price of 3s. 8d. per 1,000 cubic feet, prescribed by section 30 of the Aldershot Gas and Water Order, 1890, a standard price of 1s. 7½d. per therm.

(ii) Within the extended limits of supply of the Undertakers as defined by sections 4 and 6 of the Aldershot Gas and Water Act, 1901, a price exceeding such standard price by an amount never more than 1½d. per therm.

(iii) Within the extended limits of supply of the Undertakers as defined by section 5 of the Aldershot Gas, Water and District Lighting Act, 1909, a price exceeding such standard price by an amount never more than 2½d. per therm.

(iv) Within the extended limits of supply as defined by section 5 of and the first Schedule to the Aldershot Gas, Water and District Lighting Act, 1918, a price exceeding such standard price by an amount never more than 3½d. per therm.

### GAS REGULATION ACT, 1920.

Notice of Application by the Kingston-upon-Thames Gas Company for an Order under Section 1 of the Gas Regulation Act, 1920.

**N**OTICE is hereby given, that the Kingston-upon-Thames Gas Company (hereinafter referred to as "the Undertakers") have applied to the Board of Trade, under the provisions of Section 1 of the Gas Regulation Act, 1920, for an Order providing for—

(a) the repeal of any enactments or other provisions requiring the Undertakers to supply gas of any particular calorific value and the substitution thereof of power to charge for thermal units supplied in the form of gas; and

(b) the modification of the statutory or other provisions affecting the charges which may be made by the Undertakers by substituting for the standard price per 1,000 cubic feet now authorized with an addition to meet increases in the costs and charges of and incidental to the production and supply of gas by the Undertakers since 30th June, 1914, a standard price per therm (*i.e.*, 100,000 British Thermal Units).

The standard price now authorized in respect of the supply of gas by the Undertakers is three shillings and sixpence per 1,000 cubic feet, and the price which the Undertakers have asked the Board of Trade to substitute for this price in accordance with paragraph (b) above is 17.4 pence per therm—the sliding scale to operate below below 16 pence per therm.
