DONCASTER.

Whereas the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Doncaster (hereinafter called the Corporation), being the Urban District Council for the said Borough, have made application to the Minister of Health for the issue of a Provisional Order under Sections 297 and 303 of the Public Health Act, 1875, to partially repeal, alter or amend the Doncaster Corporation Waterworks Act, 1873, as amended by Orders relating to Doncaster which were confirmed by the Local Government Board's Provisional Orders Confirmation (Aysgarth Union, &c.) Act, 1879, and the Local Government Board's Provisional Orders Confirmation (No. 5) Act, 1883, respectively, the Doncaster Corporation Waterworks Act, 1880, and the Doncaster Corporation Act, 1915, so as:—

(1) To authorise the Corporation to construct and maintain certain additional waterworks, being two new boreholes and pumping stations at Armthorpe and Doncaster respectively, together with a water tower or elevated tank, conduits, mains and lines of pipes in connection therewith;

(2) To confer further powers upon the Corporation with reference to the control and regulation of the gathering grounds of the waterworks of the Corporation, including the making of bye-laws in relation thereto;

(3) To confer further borrowing powers upon the Corporation for the construction of the said additional waterworks, for distributing mains and for the general purposes of their waterworks undertaking; and

(4) For the several purposes of the Application or for purposes connected with, incidental to, or consequent on those purposes to make any such alteration or amendment of the said Local Acts, or of any other Local Act, or of any Act confirming a Provisional Order made in pursuance of any of the Sanitary Acts or of the Public Health Act, 1875, and in force in the said Borough as may be necessary or desirable;

And whereas it is proposed that a Provisional Order should be issued in compliance
